Our membership includes over 450 families and organizations. JILM is in partnership with LCMS Office of International Mission and provides donors a way to participate in funding specific overseas ministries that proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ. As an all-volunteer organization, we keep expenses low. As a result, 95% of the money raised reaches the mission field. To date we have provided more than \$2,744,000. To God be the Glory!
