The Jesus Is Lord Mission Story

The story of Jesus Is Lord Mission is not a "Once Upon a Time" children's story. It is the very real story of the birth of an independent mission society composed of those whose desire is to "rekindle in the leaders of the church a passion for Christ's mission."

Who Are We?

JILM is an all-volunteer mission society in partnership with LCMS Office of International Mission that provides donors a low-cost way to fund specific overseas ministries in order to widely proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ.

What Do We Do?

Unlike many mission societies, JILM does not narrow our focus to one country or area. Rather, we annually consult with the LCMS Office of International Mission and select mission projects which we fund with the contribution of members.

What Is Our Focus?

In the pattern of St. Paul, JILM generally selects projects that train people to reach their own people with the Gospel. We recognize the importance of doing so in a day when many countries are closed to foreign missionaries.

What Can We Do For You?

JILM provides you a way to join hands with LCMS brothers and sisters to further the spread of God's Kingdom. As an all-volunteer society, JILM is able to provide that at least 95 cents of each dollar you contribute goes directly to support the training of pastors, teachers and lay leaders in the selected lands. JILM informs you of the nature of our projects and of what your contributions are accomplishing.

What Have We Done?

JILM has provided over \$2,000,000 since July 2002 to train Christ co-workers to train their own people in 27 nations: Afghanistan, Argentina, Cambodia, Chile, China, Dominican Republic, East Africa, Georgia (Asia), Ghana, Guinea, Honduras, Hong Kong, India, Kazakhstan, Kyrgystan, Nigeria, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Peru, Philippines, Russia, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Togo, Turkey, United States, Vietnam and in "closed country".
